



CONDITIONS FOR:

Renewal of Single pilot (SPHPA) / Multi-pilot(MPA) type rating

After the proficiency check the following documents have to be sent to HCAA:

1. Renewal, if less than 3 months rating expired: no refresher required

- Documents according to conditions for revalidation

2. Renewal, if more than 3 months rating expired: refresher required

- Copy of relevant documents, completed and signed by training organisation, candidate, and examiner (training completion certificate, copy of the training records, etc)
- HCAA form 526 or 530 EASA PART-FCL
- Other appropriate EASA forms issued by the responsible NAA (if applicable)
- Copy of the simulator certificate
- Copy of the approval certificate/attachment issued for the training organisation
- Copy of the EASA TRE Certificate (Not required for HCAA Examiners)
- Applicant's copy of licence and valid medical certificate
- A valid endorsement of language proficiency
- Applicable HCAA fees
